Dear Friends in Christ:

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (2 Cor. 13:13).

I am pleased to present the stewardship of Time and Talent booklet, which lists the many opportunities at St. Jude of the Lake to love and serve God and neighbor.

Most people hear the word "stewardship" and think only of financial giving. Stewardship, however, actually encompasses three areas: time, talent, and treasure. God blesses us with the gifts of time, talent, and treasure and requests that we return the first fruits of these gifts back to God in gratitude, love, and thanksgiving. 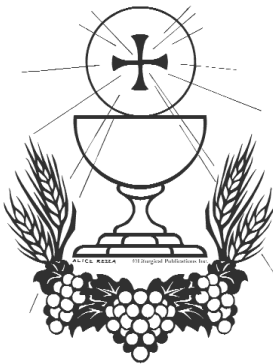

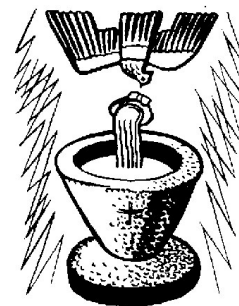
