CODE OF CONDUCT

We believe in the dignity of every person. That dignity must be respected as we gather for weekly faith formation. Giving proper respect to others includes:

- ✝ Respectful speech. Do not talk when others are talking, either catechists or other students. Name calling or other verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- ✝ Attentiveness. Follow instructions given by catechists or other leaders. This will help to make faith formation go smoothly and help everyone to learn.
- ✝ Respect of other's personal space. Keep your hands to yourself. There is to be no hitting, pushing or any conduct that is aggressive or may cause harm to others.
- ✝ Appropriate language. Using God's name disrespectfully or frivolously will not be tolerated. It is important for all children to use language that reflects our Christian values.

Faith Formation Behavior Policy

If a child engages in a consistent pattern of misbehavior, parents of the child will be contacted and asked to discuss the issue with their child to encourage more appropriate behavior.

If misbehavior persists, a parent or guardian will be required to attend classes with the child. Serious violations of the Code of Conduct may require the removal of the child from the classroom and continuation of the program in the home.

St. Jude of the Lake Faith Formation and COVID-19 policies and procedures

Due to COVID-19 and the unprecedented changes in culture and education due to the government mandated procedures, the following precautions and conditions will be undertaken.

- (1) A student may not come to class who exhibits any symptoms of ill health. Parents are responsible for ensuring the child is healthy through temperature checks, observation for symptoms, etc.
- (2) Students will bring their own masks/gaiters. A face covering will be worn while mingling with staff and students. If a health condition prevents the wearing of a face covering, no questions will be asked. We will provide disposable face covering if a student forgets to bring his/her mask.
- (3) In the event a student tests positive for COVID-19, the student will remain at home for at least 14 days or until all symptoms subside.
- (4) In the event a student tests positive for COVID-19 the entire grade will be notified via Flocknote. To protect the family's privacy, no names will be released.
- (5) In the event a student tests positive for COVID-19, in-person classes will still be held for all the grades besides the grade where a student tested positive. However, **each parent reserves the right to keep their student at home.**
- (6) At the discretion of the Faith Formation staff, classes may be cancelled and an online option for the lesson will be provided in the event COVID-19 cases escalate.
- (7) If the Minnesota state or Federal government closes places of education, then Faith Formation classes will move online.
- (8) For Faith Formation student drop-off, door 11 (cafeteria entrance) will open at 4:00pm and not before. Students will grab a snack from a station with their grade on it and then proceed to their class.
- (9) For student pick-up, parents will not enter the building to pick up their child but wait in their car/outside. Exceptions include if the child is too young to reasonably move from their classroom to the parent's car. In this case, a facial covering must be worn, and physical distancing maintained by the parent.
