



In-person Faith Formation Exposure Quarantine Protocol

St Jude of the Lake Faith Formation program is committed to keeping all our students, catechists, staff, and families safe while offering a fun faith-filled experience at Faith Formation. We have designed a plan that is flexible enough to be responsive to the ever-changing impact of COVID-19 on our local community.

Several points to note:

- Testing is one of the most helpful tools in preventing the spread of Covid-19. We are strongly recommending all students be tested after exposure to prevent possible further spread. If a student develops symptoms, they should get tested as soon as possible. If a test that is taken immediately after exposure is negative, it is recommended to repeat the test again in 3 to 5 days after exposure.
- Quarantine protocols for household exposure (multiple family members living in the same household) can be longer than the shortened quarantine options for outside of Faith Formation exposure. Please test all family members if a positive case is within your household. Please contact Frank Pavlick to determine the type of exposure and protocol for return.



Any student exposed to a positive case during their class time at Faith Formation that class will skip a week of Faith Formation.



If a student shows up to Faith Formation ill the parents will be called to promptly pick them up.
