CODE OF CONDUCT

We believe in the dignity of every person. That dignity must be respected as we gather for weekly faith formation. Giving proper respect to others includes:

- Respectful speech. Do not talk when others are talking, either catechists or other students. Name calling or other verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- ☆ Attentiveness. Follow instructions given by catechists or other leaders. This will help to make faith formation go smoothly and help everyone to learn.
- Respect of other's personal space. Keep your hands to yourself. There is to be no hitting, pushing or any conduct that is aggressive or may cause harm to others.
- ♣ Appropriate language. Using God's name disrespectfully or frivolously will not be tolerated. It is important for all children to use language that reflects our Christian values.

Faith Formation Behavior Policy

If a child engages in a consistent pattern of misbehavior, parents of the child will be contacted and asked to discuss the issue with their child to encourage more appropriate behavior.

If misbehavior persists, a parent or guardian will be required to attend classes with the child. Serious violations of the Code of Conduct may require the removal of the child from the classroom and continuation of the program in the home.
